- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 54.5394 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.5394. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE: TARLETON
- 8 STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M
- 9 University System may impose an intercollegiate athletics fee on
- 10 <u>each student enrolled at Tarleton State University in an amount not</u>
- 11 to exceed \$10 per semester credit hour.
- 12 (b) The amount of the fee imposed on a student in a semester
- or session may not exceed the amount of the fee imposed on a student
- 14 enrolled in 13 semester credit hours during the same semester or
- 15 session.
- 16 (c) The fee may not be imposed unless approved by a majority
- vote of the students of the university participating in a general
- 18 student election held for that purpose.
- 19 (d) The amount of the fee per semester credit hour may be
- 20 <u>increased from one academic year to the next only if approved by a</u>
- 21 majority vote of the legislative body of the student government of
- the university. If the amount of the increase exceeds five percent,
- 23 the increase must also be approved by a majority vote of the
- 24 students of the university participating in a general student

- 1 election held for that purpose.
- 2 (e) A fee imposed under this section may be used to develop
- 3 and maintain an intercollegiate athletics program at the
- 4 university.
- 5 (f) A fee imposed under this section is in addition to any
- 6 other fee authorized by law and may not be considered in determining
- 7 the maximum amount of student services fees that may be imposed
- 8 <u>under Section 54.503.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005 fall
- 10 semester.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
