- SECTION 2. Article 59.01(2), Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- amended by Section 2.141, Chapter 198, Section 17, Chapter 257, and
- 12 Section 3, Chapter 649, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular
- 13 Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to read as follows:
- 14 (2) "Contraband" means property of any nature,

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to the forfeiture of contraband used in the commission of an offense under Section 43.02(a)(2), Penal Code, committed on or after the effective date of this Act. Forfeiture of contraband used in the commission of an offense under Section 43.02(a)(2), Penal Code, committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before that date.
