## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to military discharge records that are recorded with or
- 3 otherwise in the possession of a governmental body.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.140(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This section applies [only] to a military veteran's
- 8 Department of Defense Form DD-214 or other military discharge
- 9 record that is [first] recorded with or [that] otherwise in [first]
- 10 comes into] the possession of a governmental body [on or after
- 11 September 1, 2003].
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 192.002(c)(1), Local Government Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (c)(1) This subsection applies [only] in relation to a
- 15 military discharge record that is recorded with a county clerk
- 16 under this section, regardless of the date of recordation [before
- 17 <u>September 1, 2003</u>].
- SECTION 3. Section 192.002(c)(3), Local Government Code, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
