9	individual to disclose the individual's social security number to
10	obtain goods or services from or enter into a business transaction
11	with the person, unless the person:
12	(1) adopts a privacy policy;
13	(2) provides the privacy policy to the individual as
14	required by Subsection (b); and
15	(3) maintains under the privacy policy the
16	confidentiality and security of a social security number disclosed
17	to the person.
18	(b) A person shall provide the person's privacy policy to an
19	individual whose social security number the person requires, by:
20	(1) reciting the policy to the individual at the time
21	the individual is required to disclose the individual's social
22	security number; or
23	(2) mailing the policy to the individual as soon as
24	practicable after the individual is required to disclose the

- 2 (c) If a person recites a privacy policy to an individual
- 3 under Subsection (b), the person shall deliver a written copy of the
- 4 policy to the individual within a reasonable time after the
- 5 individual's social security number is disclosed. The written copy
- of the privacy policy may be delivered by mail or electronically.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
