- 9 (a) The commission may [shall] adopt rules providing [the]
- 10 training  $[ \frac{1}{\tau} = \frac{1}{\tau} ]$  and seminar attendance requirements and
- 11 <u>shall adopt rules providing examination requirements</u> for persons
- who are required or who wish to be licensed or registered under this
- 13 chapter.
- 14 (c) Before a license or registration may be issued, the
- 15 person to be licensed or registered must satisfactorily complete
- 16 any [the] training, examinations, and seminars required by the
- 17 commission.
- (h) The commission may [shall] recognize, prepare, or
- 19 administer continuing education programs for its licensees and
- 20 registrants. A licensee or registrant must participate in the
- 21 programs to the extent required by the commission to keep the
- 22 person's license.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
