1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the training, examination, and seminar attendance
1-9 requirements for applicants for or holders of licenses or
1-10 registrations to perform certain activities pertaining to
1-11 compressed natural gas or liquefied natural gas.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Sections 116.034(a), (c), and (h), Natural
1-14 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-15 (a) The commission may [~~shall~~] adopt rules providing [~~the~~]
1-16 training[~~, examination,~~] and seminar attendance requirements and
1-17 shall adopt rules providing examination requirements for persons
1-18 who are required or who wish to be licensed or registered under this
1-19 chapter.

1-20 (c) Before a license or registration may be issued, the
1-21 person to be licensed or registered must satisfactorily complete
1-22 any [~~the~~] training, examinations, and seminars required by the
1-23 commission.

1-24 (h) The commission may [~~shall~~] recognize, prepare, or
1-25 administer continuing education programs for its licensees and
1-26 registrants. A licensee or registrant must participate in the
1-27 programs to the extent required by the commission to keep the
1-28 person's license.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
