- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 37.0831 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.0831. DATING VIOLENCE POLICIES. (a) Each school
- 8 district shall adopt and implement a dating violence policy to be
- 9 included in the district improvement plan under Section 11.252.
- 10 (b) A dating violence policy must:
- 11 (1) include a definition of dating violence that
- 12 <u>includes</u> the intentional use of physical, sexual, verbal, or
- 13 emotional abuse by a person to harm, threaten, intimidate, or
- 14 control another person in a continuing relationship of a romantic
- or intimate nature; and
- 16 (2) address safety planning, enforcement of
- 17 protective orders, school-based alternatives to protective orders,
- 18 training for teachers and administrators, counseling for affected
- 19 students, and awareness education for students and parents.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
