- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 81, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Section 81.009 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 81.009. APPEAL. (a) A protective order rendered under
- 7 this subtitle is a final, appealable order.
- 8 (b) An appeal of a protective order rendered under this
- 9 subtitle, with or without a supersedeas bond, does not suspend the
- 10 order. The court that rendered the protective order retains
- 11 jurisdiction to enforce the order until the appellate court
- 12 supersedes the order.
- (c) On the motion of a party or on the court's own motion,
- 14 the appellate court in its opinion may identify the parties by
- 15 fictitious names or by the parties' initials only.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a protective order
- 17 rendered on or after the effective date of this Act. A protective
- order rendered before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 19 the law in effect on the date the order was rendered, and the former
- 20 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
