5	SECTION 1. Section 411.1285(a), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) A domestic relations office created under Chapter 203,
8	Family Code, is entitled to obtain from the department criminal
9	history record information that relates to a person who is a <u>party</u>
10	to a proceeding in which the domestic relations office has been:
11	(1) appointed guardian ad litem for a child; or
12	(2) ordered to conduct [subject of] a social study
13	under Subchapter D, Chapter 107, Family Code.
14	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
15	suit affecting the parent-child relationship pending in a trial
16	court on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
17	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
