5 SECTION 1. Section 234.008, Family Code, is amended by

amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as

- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), not later
- 9 than the second business day after the date the state disbursement
- 10 unit receives a child support payment, the state disbursement unit
- 11 shall distribute the payment to the Title IV-D agency or the
- 12 obligee.
- 13 (d) In a case in which a court appoints a guardian ad litem
- 14 for the purpose of receiving, disbursing, and monitoring child
- 15 support payments, the state disbursement unit shall, after making
- any deduction required by Subsection (c), distribute the payment to
- 17 the guardian ad litem by the date required by Subsection (a). The
- 18 guardian ad litem shall deduct any amount of the guardian ad litem's
- 19 authorized fee from the payment, and promptly disburse the
- 20 remainder of the amount to the Title IV-D agency or obligee.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 234.008, Family Code, as amended by this
- 22 Act, applies to a payment distributed by the state disbursement
- 23 unit on or after the effective date of this Act. A payment
- 24 distributed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the

- 1 date the payment is distributed, and the former law is continued in
- 2 effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
