1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the appointment of certain temporary insurance agents.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 4001.162, Insurance Code, as effective
1-11 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 4001.162. RESTRICTION ON APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY
1-13 LICENSE HOLDERS. An agent, insurer, or health maintenance
1-14 organization may not appoint more than 500 [~~250~~] temporary license
1-15 holders during a calendar year.

1-16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
