- 2 relating to using county election precincts for any election held
- 3 on the November uniform election date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.002(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The county election precincts are the election
- 8 precincts for the following elections:
- 9 (1) the general election for state and county
- 10 officers;
- 11 (2) a special election ordered by the governor;
- 12 (3) a primary election; [and]
- 13 (4) a countywide election ordered by the commissioners
- 14 court, county judge, or other county authority, except an election
- subject to Section 42.062(2); and
- 16 (5) any other election held on the November uniform
- election date, as provided by Section 42.0621.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Election Code, is
- amended by adding Section 42.0621 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.0621. PRECINCTS FOR NOVEMBER ELECTION. (a) In an
- 21 election held on the November uniform election date, the
- 22 participating political subdivisions shall use the regular county
- 23 election precincts.
- 24 (b) If an election precinct is not located wholly within the

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- 1 territory of a political subdivision holding an election in the
- 2 precinct or a district used to elect an office at the election,
- 3 election officials shall take reasonable measures to ensure that a
- 4 voter voting at that precinct may not vote in an election in which
- 5 the voter is not entitled to vote.
- 6 (c) This section does not require a political subdivision to
- 7 <u>contract with a county under Section 31.092 or hold a joint election</u>
- 8 with a county under Chapter 271.
- 9 <u>(d) The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures to</u>
- 10 <u>implement this section.</u>
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 43.004, Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 43.004. DESIGNATION OF LOCATION: ELECTIONS OF OTHER
- 14 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS. (a) The governing body of each political
- 15 subdivision authorized to hold elections, other than a county,
- 16 shall designate the location of the polling place for each of its
- 17 election precincts.
- 18 (b) If a political subdivision holds an election on the
- 19 November uniform election date, the political subdivision shall
- 20 designate as the polling places for the election the regular county
- 21 polling places in the county election precincts that contain
- 22 territory from the political subdivision.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
