143.044, SECTION 3. Section Local Government Code, amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

- (d) If the criteria for fitness incentive pay are clearly established, are in writing, and are applied equally to each fire fighter or police officer in a municipality who meets the criteria, the municipality's governing body may authorize fitness incentive pay for each fire fighter or police officer who successfully meets the criteria.
- (e) The certification pay, [and] educational incentive pay, and fitness incentive pay are in addition to a fire fighter's or 1-41 1-42 police officer's regular pay. 1-43 1-44

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
