A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the payment of certain expenses of a public project
- 3 financed by certificates of obligation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 271.045, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) Work that is directly attributable under generally
- 8 accepted accounting principles to the costs of the project and that
- 9 is performed by employees of the issuer may be allocated or
- 10 attributed to the capital costs of the project.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 271.050(b), Local Government Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) The proceeds may be used only for the purposes for which
- 14 the certificates were authorized and issued. The proceeds may be
- used to pay for work done by employees of the issuer that are hired
- 16 for the specific purpose of performing work on the project. The
- 17 proceeds may be used to pay for work done by other employees of the
- 18 <u>issuer only if the issuer incurs equivalent or greater costs to</u>
- 19 replace the normal work that would have otherwise been performed by
- 20 the employees. The proceeds may not be used to reimburse the issuer
- 21 for costs that are determined to be indirect costs under generally
- 22 <u>accepted accounting principles.</u> [The proceeds may not be used to
- 23 pay for work done by employees of the issuer and paid for as work
- 24 progresses.] Any accrued interest received must be deposited in

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- 1 the interest and sinking fund established for the payment of the $\,$
- 2 certificates.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
