1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to specialty license plates for classic travel trailers.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
1-12 is amended by adding Section 504.5011 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 504.5011. CLASSIC TRAVEL TRAILERS. (a) In this
1-14 section, "travel trailer" has the meaning assigned by Section
1-15 502.166.

1-16 (b) The department shall issue specialty license plates for
1-17 a travel trailer that is at least 25 years old. The license plates
1-18 must include the words "Classic Travel Trailer" or a similar
1-19 designation.

1-20 (c) A person eligible for the license plates may instead use
1-21 license plates that were issued by this state in the same year as
1-22 the model year of the travel trailer and are approved by the
1-23 department. The department may require the attachment of a
1-24 registration insignia to the license plate in a manner that does not
1-25 affect the display of information originally on the license plate.

1-26 (d) The fee for issuance or approval of license plates under
1-27 this section is \$15.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
