- 7 (d) A person commits an offense if the person <u>uses</u> [<del>lends</del>] a
- 8 disabled parking placard issued to <u>another</u> [the] person [to a
- 9 person who uses the placard] in violation of this section.
- 10 Notwithstanding Subsections (g)-(k), an offense under this
- 11 subsection is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 12 (g) Except as provided by Subsections (d) and (h)-(k), an
- offense under this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
- 14 not less than \$250 or more than \$500.
- SECTION 2. Section 681.0111(c), Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (c) An offense under Subsection (a) is a Class A
- 18 misdemeanor. An offense under Subsection (b) is a Class  $\underline{B}$  [ $\underline{C}$ ]
- 19 misdemeanor.
- SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 21 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 22 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 23 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 24 before that date.

- 1 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 2 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
