1-9 Amend H.B. No. 1274 by striking amended Subdivision (2), Section
1-10 130.196, Education Code (House engrossment, page 1, line 27, and
1-11 substituting the following:

1-12 (2) ~~[Young,]~~ Comanche, Brown, ~~[and]~~ Erath, and Young
1-13 counties, except for the part of the Graham Independent School
1-14 District that is located in Young County.

1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the service area of the Ranger Junior College District.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 130.196, Education Code, is amended to
1-20 read as follows:

1-21 Sec. 130.196. RANGER JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE
1-22 AREA. The service area of the Ranger Junior College District
1-23 includes the territory within:

1-24 (1) the part of the Ranger Independent School District
1-25 that is located in Eastland County, except the area that is known as
1-26 the old Bullock School Land; and

1-27 (2) ~~[Young,]~~ Comanche, Brown, and Erath counties.

1-28 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
1-29 beginning with the 2005 fall semester, except that during the
1-30 2005-2006 academic year the Ranger Junior College District may
1-31 continue to treat the area removed by this Act from the district's
1-32 service area as if the area were still in the district's service
1-33 area as necessary to avoid an unreasonable interruption of junior
1-34 college services in the area.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
