11	<u>Transportation Code,</u> is excepted from the requirements of Section
12	552.021. If information in an audit working paper is also
13	maintained in another record, that other record is not excepted
14	from the requirements of Section 552.021 by this section.
15	SECTION 2. Section 552.116(b)(1), Government Code, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	(1) "Audit" means an audit authorized or required by a
18	statute of this state or the United States, the charter or an
19	ordinance of a municipality, an order of the commissioners court of
20	a county, or a resolution or other action of a joint board described
21	by Subsection (a) and includes an investigation.
22	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
23	audit working paper created before, on, or after the effective date
24	of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
