5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Chapter 152, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,

is amended by adding Section 152.006 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 152.006. FEE FOR ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

9 CENTERS. An entity described by Section 152.002(b)(1) that

provides services for the resolution of disputes in a county with a

population of 250,000 or more but less than 290,000 may collect a

reasonable fee in any amount set by the commissioners court from a

person who receives the services. Provided that nothing in this

section shall be construed to affect the collection of a fee by any

other entity described by Section 152.002(b)(1).

16 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to alternative dispute

17 resolution services provided on or after the effective date of this

18 Act. Any alternative dispute resolution services provided before

the effective date of this Act are governed by the law in effect

20 immediately before that time, and that law is continued in effect

21 for that purpose.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
