- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 152, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 152.006 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 152.006. FEE FOR ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION
- 9 CENTERS. An entity described by Section 152.002(b)(1) that
- 10 provides services for the resolution of disputes may collect a
- 11 reasonable fee in any amount set by the commissioners court from a
- 12 person who receives the services.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to alternative dispute
- 14 resolution services provided on or after the effective date of this
- 15 Act. Any alternative dispute resolution services provided before
- 16 the effective date of this Act are governed by the law in effect
- immediately before that time, and that law is continued in effect
- 18 for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
