A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to immunization requirements for children in regulated 3 child-care facilities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 42.043(b), Human Resources Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) The department shall require that each child at an 8 appropriate age have a test for tuberculosis and be immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, poliomyelitis, mumps, rubella, [and] 9 rubeola, and pneumococcal disease and against any other 10 communicable disease as recommended by the [Texas] Department of 11 12 State Health Services. The immunization must be effective on the 13 date of first entry into the facility. However, a child may be provisionally admitted if the required immunizations have begun and 14 15 are completed as rapidly as medically feasible. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 16
