5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2306.1115 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.1115. NOTICE OF FILING OF APPLICATION OR PROPOSEI
8	APPLICATION. (a) A person who files with the department ar
9	application or a proposed application for housing funds described
LO	by Section 2306.111 shall provide notice by mail to any persor
L1	residing within one-half mile of the site of the housing
L2	development described in the application. The notice must include
L3	the following information:
L4	(1) the relevant dates affecting the application,
L5	including:
L6	(A) the date on which the application was filed;
L7	(B) the date or dates on which any hearings on the
L8	application will be held; and
L9	(C) the date by which a decision on the
20	application will be made;
21	(2) a summary of relevant facts associated with the
22	development;
23	(3) a summary of any public benefits provided as a
24	result of the development, including rent subsidies and tenant

- 2 (4) the name and contact information of the employee
- 3 of the department designated by the director to act as the
- 4 information officer and liaison with the public regarding the
- 5 application.
- 6 (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date of the filing,
- 7 the person filing the application or proposed application shall
- 8 certify to the department that notice has been given as required by
- 9 Subsection (a).
- 10 (c) The department may debar a person who fails to comply
- 11 with the requirements of this section from participating in
- 12 programs under this chapter. The board by rule shall adopt a policy
- 13 providing for the debarment of a person as described by this
- 14 subsection.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a housing development
- 16 for which an application or a proposed application for housing
- 17 funds is filed with the Texas Department of Housing and Community
- 18 Affairs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
