- 2 relating to the power of a local authority to enforce compliance
- 3 with a traffic-control signal on a highway under its jurisdiction
- 4 by a photographic traffic signal enforcement system.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 542.203, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 542.203. LIMITATIONS [LIMITATION] ON LOCAL
- 9 AUTHORITIES.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 542.203, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 12 (d) A local authority may not implement or operate a
- 13 photographic traffic signal enforcement system with respect to a
- 14 highway under its jurisdiction. The attorney general shall enforce
- 15 this subsection.
- 16 (e) In this section, "photographic traffic signal
- 17 enforcement system" means a system that:
- 18 <u>(1) consists of a camera system and vehicle sensor</u>
- 19 installed to exclusively work in conjunction with an electrically
- 20 operated traffic-control signal;
- 21 (2) is capable of producing one or more recorded
- 22 photographic or digital images that depict the license plate
- 23 attached to the front or the rear of a motor vehicle that is not
- operated in compliance with the instructions of the traffic-control

- 1 signal; and
- 2 (3) is designed to enforce compliance with the
- 3 <u>instructions of the traffic-control signal by imposition of a civil</u>
- 4 or administrative penalty against the owner of the motor vehicle.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 542.202(b)(3), Transportation Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
