A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the inspection of livestock at livestock markets.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 161.114, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 161.114. INSPECTION OF LIVESTOCK. An authorized
- 7 inspector <u>may</u> [shall visually] examine [all] livestock consigned to
- 8 and delivered on the premises of a livestock market before the
- 9 livestock are offered for sale. If the inspector considers it
- 10 necessary, the inspector may have an animal tested or vaccinated.
- 11 Any testing or vaccination must occur before the animal is removed
- 12 from the livestock market.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
