- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 45.019(d), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) A complaint may be sworn to before any officer
- 9 authorized to administer oaths. The requirement of an oath under
- 10 this code is satisfied for a complaint or other related document
- 11 transmitted electronically as permitted by Article 45.012 if:
- 12 (1) all or part of the document was sworn to; and
- 13 (2) the electronic form states which parts of the
- document were sworn to and the name of the officer administering the
- 15 oath.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
