- 12 investigation of an alleged violation of Section 32.51, Penal Code
- 13 <u>(fraudulent use or possession of identifying information).</u>
- 14 (b) A business record described by Subsection (a) is
- admissible if the party offering the record has obtained the record
- from a source other than law enforcement personnel.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 18 admissibility of information in a proceeding that begins on or
- 19 after the effective date of this Act. The admissibility of
- 20 information in a proceeding that begins before the effective date
- of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 22 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 23 that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
