- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [DEFINITION]. In this chapter:
- 8 (1) "Governmental unit" has the meaning assigned by
- 9 Section 101.001.
- 10 (2) "Person" [, "person"] means an individual,
- 11 partnership, joint-stock company, unincorporated association or
- 12 society, or municipal or other corporation of any character.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 37, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- amended by adding Section 37.0021 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 37.0021. SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY NOT WAIVED. A
- 16 governmental unit does not waive immunity from suit or from
- 17 liability for attorney's fees and costs in a proceeding under this
- 18 <u>chapter.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 37.009, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 20 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 37.009. COSTS <u>AND ATTORNEY'S FEES</u>. <u>(a) Except as</u>
- 22 <u>provided by Subsection (b), in [In]</u> any proceeding under this
- 23 chapter, the court may award costs and reasonable and necessary
- 24 attorney's fees as are equitable and just.

- 3 SECTION 4. The change in law created by this Act applies
- 4 only to an action filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An action filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 6 the law applicable to the action immediately before the effective
- 7 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 8 purpose.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
