- 10 (1) \$30,000 [\$20,000] for bodily injury to or death of

- 12 (2) $\frac{\$60,000}{\$40,000}$ [$\frac{\$40,000}{\$40}$] for bodily injury to or death of
- two or more persons in one accident, subject to the amount provided
- 14 by Subdivision (1) for bodily injury to or death of one of the
- 15 persons; and
- 16 (3) $$30,000 \left[\frac{$15,000}{}\right]$ for damage to or destruction of
- 17 property of others in one accident.
- SECTION 2. Section 601.072, Transportation Code, as amended
- 19 by this Act, applies only to a motor vehicle liability insurance
- 20 policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act. A motor vehicle liability
- insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 23 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it
- 24 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
