## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the recreational facility fee at The University of 3 Texas at El Paso. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 54.541(a) and (c), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 The board of regents of The University of Texas System 7 (a) may charge each student enrolled at The University of Texas at El 8 Paso a recreational facility fee not to exceed \$100 [\$12] per 9 student for a term or semester of 10 weeks or more or \$50 for any 10 other term or semester [per semester or summer session]. 11 The fee 12 may be used only for financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, and improving new and existing recreational sports 13 14 facilities and programs at The University of Texas at El Paso. The recreational facility fee may not be increased 15 (c)

15 (c) The recreational facility fee may not be <u>increased</u>
16 [<del>levied</del>] unless the <u>amount of the increase</u> [<del>fee</del>] is approved [<del>and</del>
17 the amount of the fee is set] by <u>a</u> majority vote of those students
18 participating in a general student election called at The
19 University of Texas at El Paso for that purpose.

20 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply 21 beginning with the 2005 fall semester.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
