Section 87.125, Election Code, is amended by 19 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 20 21 (c) If the date prescribed by Subsection (a) for convening 22 the early voting ballot board is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state 23 or national holiday, the early voting ballot board shall convene on 24 the next regular business day.
