## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Articles 102.0173(a) and (d), Code of Criminal
7	Procedure, are amended to read as follows:
8	(a) The commissioners court of a county by order <u>shall</u> [may]
9	create a justice court technology fund. A defendant convicted of a
10	misdemeanor offense in justice court shall pay a \$4 justice court
11	technology fee as a cost of court for deposit in the fund [and may
12	require a defendant convicted of a misdemeanor offense in a justice
13	court to pay a technology fee not to exceed \$4 as a cost of court].
14	(d) A fund designated by this article may be used only to
15	finance:
16	(1) the cost of continuing education and training for
17	justice court judges and clerks regarding technological
18	enhancements for justice courts; and
19	(2) the purchase <u>and maintenance</u> of technological
20	enhancements for a justice court, including:
21	(A) $[(1)]$ computer systems;
22	(B) [ $(2)$ ] computer networks;
23	(C) [ <del>(3)</del> ] computer hardware;

(D) [<del>(4)</del>] computer software;

- 27 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 6 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 7 committed before that date.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
