- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 826.0211(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Information [that is] contained in a rabies vaccination
- 8 certificate or in any record compiled from the information
- 9 <u>contained in one or more certificates</u> that identifies or tends to
- 10 identify an [the] owner or an address, telephone number, or other
- 11 personally identifying information of an [the] owner of a [the]
- 12 vaccinated animal is confidential and not subject to disclosure
- 13 under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
