- 8 Sec. 5.5145. EMERGENCY ORDER CONCERNING OPERATION OF ROCK
- 9 CRUSHER OR CONCRETE PLANT WITHOUT PERMIT. (a) The commission shall
- 10 issue an emergency order under this subchapter suspending
- 11 operations of a rock crusher or a concrete plant that performs wet
- 12 batching, dry batching, or central mixing and is required to obtain
- 13 a permit under Section 382.0518, Health and Safety Code, and is
- 14 operating without the necessary permit.
- (b) Subsection (a) applies only to a rock crusher or
- 16 concrete plant for which the owner or operator has failed to obtain
- 17 a necessary permit or for which the permit has been suspended or
- 18 revoked and does not apply to a rock crusher or concrete plant for
- 19 which the permit has expired.
- SECTION 2. Section 7.052(b), Water Code, is amended to read

- (b) The amount of the penalty for operating a rock crusher
- or a concrete plant that performs wet batching, dry batching, or

- 1 382.0518, Health and Safety Code, and that is operating without the
- 2 required permit is \$10,000. The amount of the penalty for
- 3 constructing a rock crusher described by this subsection without
- 4 the required permit may not be less than \$5,000 or more than
- 5 \$10,000. [Each day that a continuing violation occurs is a separate
- 6 violation.
- 7 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 a violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 A violation that occurs before that date is governed by the law in
- 10 effect at the time the violation occurred, and that law is continued
- 11 in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
