5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is

7 Sec. 55.17513. TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL

8 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this

subchapter, the board of regents of The Texas A&M University System

may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or

equip property, buildings, structures, or other facilities,

including roads and related infrastructure, for Texas A&M

University--Texarkana, to be financed by the issuance of bonds in

accordance with this subchapter, including bonds issued in

accordance with a systemwide revenue financing program and secured

as provided by that program, in an aggregate principal amount not to

18 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of

bonds authorized by Subsection (a) all or any part of the revenue

funds of an institution, branch, or entity of The Texas A&M

21 <u>University System, including student tuition charges.</u> The amount

23 abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds

issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.
