H.B. No. 1442

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to a requirement that school districts publish certain information at the beginning of each school year.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 11.169 to read as follows:

Sec. 11.169. PUBLICATION OF CERTAIN INFORMATION REQUIRED.

Not later than the 10th day after the first day of instruction of each school year, a school district shall publish the following information in a newspaper of general circulation in the district:

(1) the district's performance rating under Section 39.072;

(2) the total number of students enrolled in the district;

(3) the total number of classroom teachers employed by the district;

(4) the total number of employees other than classroom teachers employed by the district;

(5) the average annual salary of a classroom teacher employed by the district;

(6) the average annual salary of a district administrator other than the superintendent;

(7) the annual salary of the district superintendent;
and

1 (8) the average annual salary of a district employee
2 who is not an administrator or a classroom teacher, computed using
3 the salaries of all district employees other than classroom
4 teachers, administrators, and the superintendent.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
