- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.428(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The permit to compost grease trap waste must:
- 8 <u>(1)</u> meet the minimum standards of a permit issued under
- 9 rules adopted under Subsection (b); and
- 10 (2) require the grease trap waste to be dewatered at an
- 11 authorized processing facility before it is composted.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) On or after January 1, 2006, a person may
- 13 not commercially compost grease trap waste, as defined by the Texas
- 14 Commission on Environmental Quality, unless the person holds a
- permit issued by the commission under Sections 361.428(d) and (e),
- 16 Health and Safety Code.
- 17 (b) Section 2, Chapter 596, Acts of the 78th Legislature,
- 18 Regular Session, 2003, is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 20 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
- 21 (b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect January 1, 2006.
