4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 292, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 292.030 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 292.030. ANNEX FACILITIES IN CERTAIN POPULOUS
8	COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a county that:
9	(1) has a population of more than 350,000;
10	(2) is adjacent to a county with a population of 3.3
11	million or more; and
12	(3) contains any part of a municipality that is
13	located in three or more counties.
14	(b) The commissioners court of the county may purchase,
15	construct, maintain, or provide for by other means an annex
16	facility for providing county services outside the county seat.

- (c) Any county officer may maintain an office and the county
- 18 may provide any county service at the annex facility authorized by
- 19 this section. The maintenance of an office or the provision of a
- 20 service at the annex facility must be in addition to an office
- 21 maintained or service provided at any other location required by
- 22 <u>law.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
