(a) The board, as the result of a complaint filed with the 9 board or on the board's own motion, may refer an applicant for or 10 11 recipient of financial assistance from the board to the commission, 12 the state auditor's office, the Texas Rangers, or another state agency, office, or division, as appropriate, for the investigation 13 14 of, or the initiation of an enforcement action against, the applicant or recipient. 15 (b) The executive administrator shall transmit the referral 16 to the appropriate state agency, office, or division, monitor the 17 18 progress of the investigation or enforcement action, and report to the board on a quarterly basis. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
