- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 824.601, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The system may not withhold a monthly benefit payment
- 8 under this section from a retiree who:
- 9 (1) before January 1, 2005, retired under Section
- 10 <u>824.202; and</u>

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- 11 (2) is employed by a school district or an
- open-enrollment charter school, other than a third-party entity.
- SECTION 2. Section 824.602(a), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Subject to Section 825.506, the retirement system may
- 16 not, under Section 824.601, withhold a monthly benefit payment if
- 17 the retiree is employed in a Texas public educational institution:
- 18 (1) as a substitute only with pay not more than the
- daily rate of substitute pay established by the employer and, if the
- 20 retiree is a disability retiree, the employment has not exceeded a
- 21 total of 90 days in the school year;
- 22 (2) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
- 23 more than a one-half time basis for the month;
- 24 (3) in one or more positions on as much as a full-time

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- 1 basis, if the work occurs in not more than six months of a school
- 2 year that begins after the retiree's effective date of retirement;
- 3 (4) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
  - more than a one-half time basis for no more than 90 days in the
- 5 school year, if the retiree is a disability retiree;
- 6 (5) in a position as a classroom teacher on as much as
- 7 a full-time basis, if the retiree has retired under Section
- 8 824.202(a), is certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education
- 9 Code, to teach the subjects assigned, [is teaching in an acute
- 10 shortage area as determined by the board of trustees of a school
- 11 district as provided by Subsection (m), and has been separated
- 12 from service with all public schools for at least 12 months;
- 13 (6) in a position as a principal, including as an
- 14 assistant principal, on as much as a full-time basis, if the retiree
- 15 has retired under Section 824.202(a) without reduction for
- 16 retirement at an early age, is certified under Subchapter B,
- 17 Chapter 21, Education Code, to serve as a principal, and has been
- 18 separated from service with all public schools for at least 12
- 19 months; or

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- 20 (7) as a bus driver for a school district on as much as
- 21 a full-time basis, if the retiree has retired under Section
- 22 824.202(a).
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
