A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the issuance of special license plates to benefit
- 3 certain programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.608, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 504.608. MOTHERS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING [TEXAS
- 8 COMMISSION ON ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE] LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 9 department shall issue specialty license plates that include the
- 10 words "Mothers Against Drunk Driving [Boy Scouts of America]." The
- 11 department shall design the license plates in consultation with
- 12 Mothers Against Drunk Driving [the Boy Scouts of America].
- 13 (b) After deduction of the department's administrative
- 14 costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates
- shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue fund and may
- 16 be appropriated only to the Texas <u>Higher Education Coordinating</u>
- 17 Board in making grants to benefit [Commission on Alcohol and Drug
- 18 Abuse for drug-abuse prevention and education programs sponsored
- 19 by Mothers Against Drunk Driving [provided by nonprofit
- 20 organizations that primarily serve children].
- 21 [(c) In selecting a program provider under Subsection (b),
- 22 it is the intent of the legislature that, to the extent permissible,
- 23 preference be given to a provider whose membership substantially
- 24 consists of persons who purchase the specialty license plates.

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- SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Section 504.6545 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 504.6545. BOY SCOUT LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 4 department shall issue specialty license plates that include the
- 5 words "Boy Scouts of America." The department shall design the
- 6 license plates in consultation with the Boy Scouts of America.
- 7 (b) After deduction of the department's administrative
- 8 costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates
- 9 shall be deposited to the credit of the Boy Scout account in the
- 10 general revenue fund. Money in the account may be used only by the
- 11 Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board in making grants to
- 12 benefit educational projects sponsored by Boy Scout councils in
- 13 <u>this state.</u>
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
