- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 472.022, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 472.022. OBEYING WARNING SIGNS AND BARRICADES.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 472.022(a), (d), and (e),
- 9 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 11 (1) disobeys the instructions, signals, warnings, or
- 12 markings of a warning sign; or
- 13 (2) drives around a barricade.
- 14 (d) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- punishable by a fine of not less than \$1 or more than \$200, except
- 16 that:
- 17 (1) if the offense is committed in a construction or
- 18 maintenance work zone when workers are present and any written
- 19 notice to appear issued for the offense states on its face that
- 20 workers were present when the offense was committed, the offense is
- 21 a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$2 or more than
- 22 \$400; or
- 23 (2) if a person commits an offense under Subsection
- 24 (a) where a warning sign or barricade has been placed because water

- 1 is over any portion of a road, street, or highway, the offense is a
- 2 <u>Class B misdemeanor</u>.
- 3 (e) In this section:
- 4 (1) "Barricade" means an obstruction:
- 5 (A) placed on or across a road, street, or
- 6 highway of this state by the department, a political subdivision of
- 7 this state, or a contractor or subcontractor constructing or
- 8 repairing the road, street, or highway under authorization of the
- 9 department or a political subdivision of this state; and
- 10 (B) placed to prevent the passage of motor
- 11 vehicles over the road, street, or highway during construction,
- 12 [or] repair, or dangerous conditions.
- 13 (2) "Construction or maintenance work zone" means a
- 14 portion of a highway or street:
- 15 (A) where highway construction or maintenance is
- 16 being undertaken, other than mobile operations as defined by the
- 17 Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and
- 18 (B) that is marked by signs:
- 19 (i) indicating that it is a construction or
- 20 maintenance work zone;
- 21 (ii) indicating where the zone begins and
- 22 ends; and
- 23 (iii) stating: "Fines double when workers
- 24 present."
- 25 (3) "Warning sign" means a signal, marking, or device
- 26 placed on a barricade or on a road, street, or highway during
- 27 [under] construction, [or] repair, or dangerous conditions by the

- 1 department, a political subdivision of this state, or a contractor
- 2 or subcontractor to warn or regulate motor vehicular traffic. The
- 3 term includes a flagger deployed on a road, street, or highway by
- 4 the department, a political subdivision of this state, or a
- 5 contractor or subcontractor to direct traffic around or on the
- 6 road, street, or highway <u>during</u> [<u>under</u>] construction, [or] repair,
- 7 <u>or dangerous conditions</u>.
- 8 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 9 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 10 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 11 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 12 before that date.
- 13 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 14 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
