| 8  | from the fund must be made to recipients with 100 or fewer employees |
| 9  | who commit to contribute the recipient's own money to the            |
| 10 | enterprise for which the grant is made in an amount equal to at      |
| 11 | least one-third of the amount of the grant and who commit to provide |
| 12 | a health benefit plan to the recipients' employees. Of the grants    |
| 13 | made under this subsection:  |
| 14 | (1) at least 50 percent must be made to recipients with              |
| 15 | not more than 15 employees; and                                      |
| 16 | (2) at least 25 percent must be made to recipients with              |
| 17 | more than 15 and not more than 50 employees.                         |
| 18 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.                  |
