5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 35, Business & Commerce
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 35.551 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 35.551. TICKET SCALPING. (a) In this section:
8	(1) "Event" means an event of public entertainment or
9	amusement.
10	(2) "Event sponsor" means an owner, lessee, operator,
11	promoter, or manager of an event or the site of an event.
12	(3) "Resell" means to sell a ticket after it has been
13	purchased from the event sponsor or from an individual,
14	corporation, or association authorized to sell the ticket by the
15	event sponsor.
16	(b) A person may not resell or offer to resell a ticket to an
17	event for a price that is more than the price authorized to be
18	offered to the public by the event sponsor unless the person:
19	(1) is in the full-time business of reselling tickets
20	to events; and
21	(2) resells the ticket or offers to resell the ticket
22	at a permanent location from which the person engages in that
23	business.
24	(c) A person who violates this section commits an offense.
