5	SECTION 1. Section 277.002(a), Election Code, is amended to

7	(a) For a petition signature to be valid, a petition must:
8	(1) contain in addition to the signature:
9	(A) the signer's printed name;
10	(B) the signer's:
11	(i) date of birth [and residence address];

13	(ii) voter registration number and, if the
14	territory from which signatures must be obtained is situated in
15	more than one county, the county of registration; [and]
16	(C) the signer's residence address; and
17	(D) the date of signing; and
18	(2) comply with any other applicable requirements
19	prescribed by law.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a petition filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
22	petition filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
23	the law in effect when the petition was filed, and the former law is

24 continued in effect for that purpose.
