5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 11.085, Water Code, is amended by adding
7	Subsection (w) to read as follows:
8	(w) Subsections (s) and (t) do not apply to a proposed
9	transfer between river basins that are located wholly or partly
10	within a single regional water planning area designated in
11	accordance with Section 16.053 if the regional water planning area
12	contains within its boundaries:
13	(1) one or more classes of groundwater users that are
14	subject to a regulatory requirement to reduce groundwater usage due
15	wholly or partly to land subsidence, either at the time of the
16	proposed transfer or at a later specified date;
17	(2) all or part of a county with a population of more
18	than 3.3 million; and
19	(3) all or part of at least three river basins.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 11.085(w),
21	Water Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a proposed
22	interbasin transfer of water to which that section applies, the
23	application for a permit for which is:
24	(1) submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental

1 Quality on or after the effective date of this Act; or

2 (2) pending before the Texas Commission on
3 Environmental Quality on the effective date of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
