CHAPTER 2206. PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO STATE AND LOCAL

8 <u>PUBLIC PROPERTY</u>

- 9 <u>Sec. 2206.001. DEROGATORY NAMES OR DESIGNATIONS OF PUBLIC</u>
 10 <u>PROPERTY PROHIBITED.</u> (a) In this section, "public property"
 11 includes buildings, streets, and parks.
- 12 (b) This section applies to all governmental entities in or
 13 of this state, including state agencies, municipalities, counties,
 14 special districts, and any other political subdivision of this
 15 state.
- 16 <u>(c) In naming or giving a designation to public property, a</u>
 17 governmental entity may not use a name or designation that is
 18 derogatory to a racial or ethnic group.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 2206, Government Code, as added by this
 Act, applies only to the naming of public property that occurs on or
 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
