gathered in dangerous proximity to a fire, riot, or other hazard; or 1 2 (3) discharges fireworks, as defined by Section 3 2154.001, Occupations Code: 4 (A) within 300 feet of a highway, street, sidewalk, railway, waterway, elevator, aisle, hallway, entrance, 5 6 or exit to which the public or a substantial group of the public has access, or any other place used for the passage of persons, 7 vehicles, or conveyances; and 8 9 (B) in a manner reasonably likely to disrupt the passage of persons, vehicles, or conveyances. 10 (c) An offense under <u>Subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2)</u> [this 11 section] is a Class B misdemeanor. An offense under Subsection 12 (a)(3) is a Class C misdemeanor. 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 18
