A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to removal of corneal tissue from a decedent.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 693, Health and Safety
- 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 693.006 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 693.006. REMOVAL OF CORNEAL TISSUE. On a request from
- an eye bank, as defined in Section 692.002, the medical examiner,
- 8 justice of the peace, county judge, or physician designated by the
- 9 justice of the peace or county judge may permit the removal of
- 10 corneal tissue subject to the same provisions that apply to removal
- 11 of a visceral organ on the request of an organ procurement
- 12 organization under this subchapter. The provisions of this
- 13 <u>subchapter relating immunity and consent apply to the removal of</u>
- 14 the corneal tissue.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 693, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, is repealed.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to removal of corneal
- 18 tissue on or after September 1, 2005. Removal of corneal tissue
- 19 before September 1, 2005, is governed by the law in effect
- 20 immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect
- 21 for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
