- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 202.001(a)(4), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (4) "Podiatry" means the treatment of or offer to
- 7 treat any disease, disorder, <u>condition</u>, physical injury,
- 8 deformity, or ailment of the human foot, ankle, and related
- 9 structures, including structures that affect the function of the
- 10 human foot, ankle, or related structures, by any system or method.
- 11 The term includes podiatric medicine.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
