3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 545.352(b), Transportation Code, as
5	amended by Chapters 663, 739, and 1346, Acts of the 76th
6	Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, is reenacted and amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(b) Unless a special hazard exists that requires a slower
9	speed for compliance with Section 545.351(b), the following speeds
10	are lawful:
11	(1) <u>in [30 miles per hour in]</u> an urban district:
12	(A) [on a street other than an alley and] 15 miles
13	per hour in an alley;
14	(B) 20 miles per hour in a residence district;
15	and
16	(C) 30 miles per hour on a street other than ar
17	alley or in a residence district;

- 18 (2) 70 miles per hour in daytime and 65 miles per hour
- in nighttime if the vehicle is on a highway numbered by this state
- 20 or the United States outside an urban district, including a
- 21 farm-to-market or ranch-to-market road, except as provided by
- 22 Subdivision (4);
- 23 (3) 60 miles per hour in daytime and 55 miles per hour
- 24 in nighttime if the vehicle is on a highway that is outside an urban

- 1 district and not a highway numbered by this state or the United
- 2 States;
- 3 (4) outside an urban district:
- 4 (A) 60 miles per hour if the vehicle is a school
- 5 bus that has passed a commercial motor vehicle inspection under
- 6 Section 548.201 and is on a highway numbered by the United States or
- 7 this state, including a farm-to-market road;
- 8 (B) 50 miles per hour if the vehicle is a school
- 9 bus that:
- 10 (i) has not passed a commercial motor
- 11 vehicle inspection under Section 548.201; or
- 12 (ii) is traveling on a highway not numbered
- 13 by the United States or this state; or
- 14 (C) 60 miles per hour in daytime and 55 miles per
- 15 hour in nighttime if:
- 16 (i) the vehicle is a truck, other than a
- 17 light truck, or if the vehicle is a truck tractor, trailer, or
- 18 semitrailer; and
- 19 (ii) the vehicle is on a farm-to-market or
- 20 ranch-to-market road;
- 21 (5) on a beach, 15 miles per hour; or
- 22 (6) on a county road adjacent to a public beach, 15
- 23 miles per hour, if declared by the commissioners court of the
- 24 county.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
